By the grace of God, Holy Family Radio was able to expand Catholic radio further into the Kalamazoo Diocese when they fired up a new station, WSPB 89.7 FM on Saturday, May 24, 2014.



This new station has the potential to bring the fullness of the Catholic faith to a population of over 333,000 people and will fill some of the gap between Holy Family Radio's 1140 AM Kentwood/Grand Rapids station and the 91.5 FM Vicksburg/Kalamazoo station. The three (3) stations together will proclaim the Good News to approximately 1.5 million people in West and Southwest Michigan plus countless more on the road.

Over half the funds have been raised for the construction of WSPB. However, an additional \$55,000 is still needed. 
